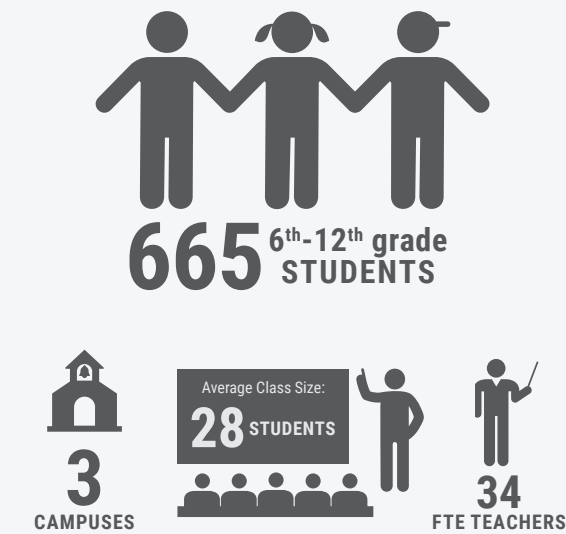

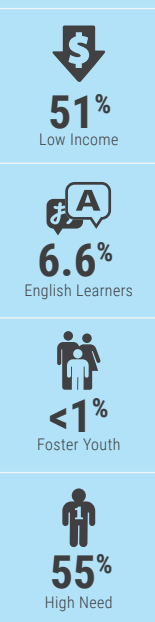

To develop students to be respectful citizens, active communicators, open-minded and technologically proficient thinkers and problem solvers, and self-directed learners.

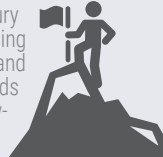

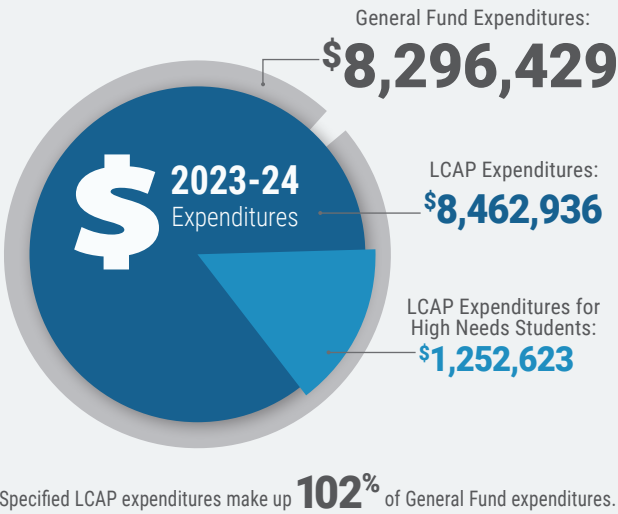
AAV emphasizes a STEM-focused curriculum, 1:1 technology, and close-knit campuses to prepare students for college and career success.

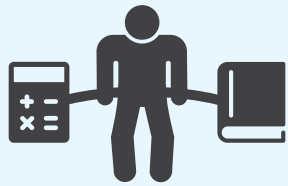

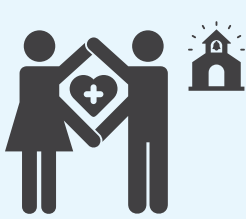

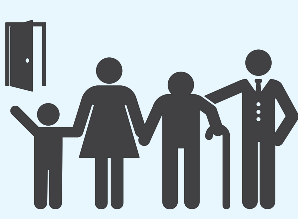
